They agreed on the condition they could teach dances from their rock 'n roll repertoire, such as the R&R Waltz and the Box Rhumba. Betty says it's always a special night and it brings the young people together in a formal situation. "I always tell them it's something you'll never forget," she says. Betty remembers her own Deb Ball in Pyramid Hill in 1958. "You feel like a princess."

#### SILAGE WRAP RECYCLING SERVICE

Local farmers can now dispose of their silage wrap for free at Council's Cohuna Transfer Station. Wrap needs to be shaken and as clean as possible and will be accepted in Bulka bags, wool bags or Plasback bags without net wrap or twine. Silage wrap is made of a high quality linear low-density polyethylene plastic which is a wasted resource if sent to landfill. Please note that burning silage wrap is illegal and it also releases harmful chemicals into the atmosphere.

#### THE LOCAL BOOKSHELF


"If you don't like to read, you haven't found the right book." J.K. Rowling. Here's a mixture of titles to tempt a range of interests....



Lisa, by Lisa Curry and Ellen Whinnett.



#### *Horse*, by Geraldine Brooks.

backdrop for this story.




#### **Deception**, by Lesley Pearse.




