

# Cohuna community celebrates childcare centre commitment

Cohuna and district residents who have advocated for the establishment of a childcare centre for the town have welcomed a key step in the long journey to see this come to fruition.

In December the State Government announced that as part of its commitment to improve early childhood education opportunities, it will establish a government-owned childhood learning and childcare centre, to be open in 2027 or 2028.

The announcement builds on many years of work completed by families seeking improved childcare options for Cohuna, with Gannawarra Shire Council agreeing in April 2021 to work with the community to investigate the creation of a childcare facility for the town.

"Last week's announcement by the State Government is a major relief. To know that all our hard work over the last few years has come to fruition is an unbelievable feeling," Tenielle Edge, who coordinated a community-led campaign for improved childcare availability for Cohuna, said. "Over the course of the journey, we have hit so many brick walls, at many times it felt as if all the hard work was for nothing, but that is all a distant memory now. I understand that the announcement does not fix the predicament that families are in right now, but it was never going to be fixed overnight. In years to come, it is my hope that families in Cohuna don't have a childcare issue, and that accessing childcare is as simple as making a phone call."

Council Chief Executive Officer, Geoff Rollinson said "Council will work with the State Government and educational providers regarding the location of the new centre at Cohuna and construction timelines, as well as the rollout of a Pre-Prep program, which will replace the current four-year-old kindergarten structure across the Gannawarra from 2025."

### **WHAT CAN YOU RETURN?**



Check for the 10c mark







- Aluminium cans
- Plastic bottles
- Glass bottles
- Paperboard cartons (under 11.)
- Steel bottles/cans

Most beverage containers (between 150mL and 3L) made from aluminium, glass, plastic, steel and liquid paperboard are eligible.

### Ineligible



- Wine and spirit bottles
- Milk containers
- Paperboard cartons (over 11.)
- Cordial bottles

Don't throw these out! Ineligible containers may still be accepted in your kerbside recycling bin.

### **Council Working to Control Mosquito Numbers Around Towns**

Gannawarra Shire Council has increased mosquito surveillance and control following major rain events. Parts of the Gannawarra have received 200-300 millimetres of rain since Christmas Day, with stagnant water and warm weather providing ideal breeding conditions for mosquitoes over the coming weeks. Whilst most mosquitoes are just a nuisance, others can carry diseases, such as Ross River Virus Disease and Japanese Encephalitis.

Staff have started targeting known locations around population centres, including roadside drains, public parks, and residential water basins. Proactive treatment to reduce mosquito breeding will be the priority. Some targeted fogging to kill adult mosquitoes on public land may also occur where this is deemed necessary to

reduce the risk to public health. Mosquito control is a communitywide issue and residents are responsible for reducing the opportunity for mosquitoes to breed on private property.



Mosquitoes breed in small amounts of warm stagnant water and residents should remove stagnant water and keep the area around homes well maintained to reduce mosquito breeding sites on their own properties. A knockdown fly-spray or surface spray can be effective in reducing adult mosquitoes and the risk of being bitten around homes.

To reduce mosquito breeding on larger properties, mosquito control products are readily available. Residents can protect themselves from being bitten by limiting outdoor activity when mosquitoes are most active, wearing long, loose fitting clothes, and applying a mosquito repellent containing picaridin or DEET to exposed skin when outdoors.
